Now, let's consider his likely physical plight. Read 2 Samuel 16:5 through the end of 2 Samuel 17, and as you do:

- Put a box around any location you see (this can be a city, river, or a general location like "beyond the summit") and take note of what happened in that location.
- Double underline any name and try to understand what their location is and what their role is in regard to David.
- Place a star over anything you see that might make David weary.

There are two main groups of people moving about in 2 Samuel: David's people and Absalom's people. Map David's locations and movements in red and Absalom's locations and movements in green.
