SUGGESTED FOR THE WEEK OF

September 22



This is a story about two men who walked on water. One succeeded, but the other failed. The one who failed did so on his own. In fact, he was only able to stay above the water as long as he did because of his faith in the One who allowed it. Only Jesus had the power to allow Peter to walk on the waves before he began to sink. Why did Jesus come to the disciples on the water? Why did Peter want to step out of the boat and go to Him? Why did Peter sink?

Jesus sent the Twelve across the water in a boat while He dismissed the crowd who had followed Him. Then Jesus went away alone to pray on a mountain. Some time between 3 and 6 a.m., Jesus returned to His disciples on the water. The disciples thought their Lord was a ghost, but when Jesus identified Himself, Peter wanted to join Him. With his eyes on Jesus, Peter walked out to meet Him. Diverting his attention to the wind, Peter began to sink. In fear he cried out to his Savior. Immediately, Jesus reached out and took hold of Peter—the Savior saved him! Jesus opened Peter's eyes to his failure and revealed his "little faith." Back in the boat, the wind stopped, and a worship service ensued.

Where do you place yourself in this story? Are you clinging to the boat with eyes closed or looking around to see what is happening? Do you dare venture out to meet Jesus? How much faith do you have in Christ?



JESUS WALKED ON WATER

-Based on Matthew 14:22-33

BIBLE STORY FOR 1s

- » Jesus' helpers were in a boat.
- » Jesus walked on the water toward the boat.
- » Peter asked to come to Jesus. He did! Peter walked on the water until he got scared. Jesus reached down and helped him. The men got on the boat.
- » The men worshiped (sang to, thanked, praised) Jesus. The helpers knew that Jesus was the Son of God.

BIBLE STORY FOR 2s

- » Jesus' helpers were in a boat. Strong winds made waves hit the boat.
- » The helpers saw Jesus walking on the water toward the boat. They were scared. But Jesus told them not to be scared.
- » Peter asked to come to Jesus. He did! Peter walked on the water until he got scared again. Peter began to sink in the water. Jesus helped him.
- » The men worshiped (sang to, thanked, praised) Jesus. The helpers knew that Jesus was the Son of God.

GATHER TIME FOR OLDER 2s

- Sather and sing. Blow bubbles to draw preschoolers' attention. Lead the children to the gather time area. Sing "Mighty Is He." Guide boys and girls to sit where they can see your Bible.
- Tell the Bible story and review. Invite someone to retrieve the Teaching Picture from your Bible. Mention that our Bible story today is found in the New Testament in the Bible. Tell the story slowly and with feeling, being sure to emphasize the storm and Peter's fear. Highlight that Jesus helped Peter and that all of Jesus' helpers knew He (Jesus) was God's Son.
- > Learn the Bible Verse. Ask: "Who walked on the water? (Jesus and Peter) Who was afraid?" (Peter) Invite a preschooler to help open your Bible to the Weekly Verse and to hold up the verse. Mention that when you say "Jesus" you want them to stand up and to walk in place like Peter might have done on the water. Read aloud the verse again and tell the boys and girls to sit down when you say "Jesus." Repeat the verse and motions several times, inviting boys and girls to join you in saying "Jesus" each time.
- Wrap it up. Sing "What Did Jesus Do?" once. Tell the boys and girls to stand and walk in place while you sing again. Sit back down and invite preschoolers to pray, saying thank you to God for loving us.

BIBLE-LEARNING ACTIVITIES

STAMP FOOTPRINTS

Print today's Bible Marker for each child. Glue the marker on each paper.

- » Say the Weekly Verse, pointing to it on a paper.
- » Help put on smocks.
- » Demonstrate how to stamp on the ink pad and then on the paper.
- » Allow preschoolers to use a variety of colors and to make multiple footprints as they are interested.
- » Guide preschoolers to tell you what they remember about today's Bible story as they work on their pictures.

PLAY A MATCHING GAME

Cut apart the Matching Helpers cards. Scatter them faceup inside a plastic hoop.

- » Show the Teaching Picture, asking children to point to Jesus.
- » Remark that Jesus helped people because He loved them. Say: "We can love and help people, too."
- » Explain that all of the pictures in the hoop are of boys and girls helping others.
- » Guide preschoolers to take turns finding two pictures that match and then to tell you what is happening in the picture.
- » Continue until each set of pictures is matched.
- » Scatter the pictures for children to play again.

TRACE FEET

- » Remind boys and girls that after Peter saw Jesus walking on the water Peter walked on the water until he was afraid.
- » Remark that Jesus can do things we cannot do!
- » Tell the boys and girls to select paper for you to trace their feet.
- » On one side of the paper trace with shoes on.
- » Guide preschoolers to color their pictures and then to try to stand on the outlines of their feet.
- » Encourage the boys and girls to think about Jesus walking on the water when they look at the footprints.

DISCOVER PICTURES OF JESUS

- » Invite boys and girls to hear a story about Jesus.
- » Read today's Bible story from one of the children's Bibles to interested children and talk about the pictures they see.
- » Encourage the boys and girls to look in the other Bibles and storybooks for pictures of Jesus, children, and/or His helpers.
- » Remark that the Bible has lots of stories about Jesus, God's Son.
- » Pray together, thanking God that Jesus helped people because He loved them.

WORK PUZZLES

- » Remark that the people on the boat in today's Bible story loved Jesus.
- » Work the puzzles.
- » Allow boys and girls to take turns saying "Jesus helped people."
- » Say: "Thank You, God, for Jesus."

SING A SONG

- Show the Teaching Pictures in order one by one and say the line from the Jesus Song that corresponds to the picture.
- » Sing the song, leading the children to mimic your motions.
- » Repeat the song several times, asking another leader to point to each Teaching Picture as it is included in the song.
- » Display the missions pictures and read about the Rigneys. Comment that Addison likes to sing. State that she can sing songs about Jesus to others.

PRETEND TO WALK ON WATER

Spread the sheet on the floor. Tape a large rectangle on part of the sheet.

- » Invite a few children to pretend to be Jesus' disciples (helpers) and stand inside the boat (taped rectangle).
- » Let one child pretend to be Jesus and walk toward the boat on the sheet.
- » Let another child pretend to be Peter and walk toward Jesus.
- » Take turns letting the children play out the Bible story.
- » Comment that Jesus can do things we cannot do.
- » Say that the men on the boat worshiped (sang to, thanked, praised) Jesus.
- » Sing "We Can Praise the Lord" with the children.

CELEBRATE THAT JESUS LOVES US

- » Remind boys and girls that our Bible Verse today says: "The people on the boat worshiped Jesus, God's Son."
- » Encourage children to celebrate Jesus by having a fun party. Direct them to help get ready for a celebration by setting out the colorful plates and napkins.
- » Guide children to tape streamers on the backs of their chairs.
- » Older preschoolers can pretend to welcome people to their party by saying "We love Jesus!"
- » Remind the preschoolers that Jesus can do things we cannot do.

CLEAN UP

» Play "We Can Work" as you lead the children to clean the room.

BIBLE-LEARNING ACTIVITIES

SONG

Sing to the tune of "Are You Sleeping?": Jesus walked across the water. What a sight! What a sight! Jesus is so special; Jesus is so special. He loves us; He loves us.

WALK ON A TAPED LINE

Gather: masking or painters tape **Do:** Tape a long line on the floor.

- » Mention that in today's Bible story Jesus walked on the water.
- Say that we cannot walk on water. Mention that Jesus could do things no one else could do.
- » Invite children to walk on the tape line.
- » Urge boys and girls to practice saying "Jesus is powerful."

PLAY WITH BOATS

Gather: toy boats, blocks

- Invite boys and girls to use the blocks to build docks for the boats to go in.
- » Talk about the different kinds of boats.
- Mention that the disciples (helpers) were on a boat when Jesus walked to them.
- » Say that Jesus did things no one else could do.
- Tell that the people on the boat worshiped Jesus, God's Son.

TOSS THE BEANBAG

Gather: Teaching Pictures 1–4, beanbag **Do:** Place the Teaching Pictures side by side on the floor.

- Invite the children to take turns tossing the beanbag on the pictures of Jesus.
- » Identify each picture that a beanbag lands on.
- Remind the children that Jesus is powerful and can do things no one else can do.
- Challenge older 2s to toss the beanbag onto correct Teaching Pictures as you identify particular features in the pictures.

WORK PUZZLES

Gather: Bible, puzzles of community helpers

- » Open a Bible to today's Bible story.
- Remind the preschoolers that our Bible story is from the Bible and that the Bible is true and has stories about Jesus.
- Mention as children work the puzzles that community helpers help people and that Jesus helped people because He loved them.
- Guide preschoolers to think of ways they can help people.

PLAY WITH WATER

Gather: 2 plastic tubs, measuring cups, funnels, plastic ladles, large spoons, kitchen towels **Do:** Fill the tubs 2 inches deep with water and place tubs on kitchen towels. Closely supervise water play.

- » Mention to the boys and girls that the Bible tells us that Jesus walked on water.
- Suide the boys and girls to use the different implements to measure and pour water.
- » Remind them to keep the water inside the tubs.
- You may want to play soft music while the children are enjoying the water.
- » Guide preschoolers to take turns and to say: "Jesus is powerful."
- » State that Jesus can do things I cannot do.

CLEAN UP

Lead children to help put toys in the correct places.

DISMISS

Place all the children's personal items inside their diaper bags. Remind parents to do the activities and review the Bible story this week on the Kids Activity Page.

Step Over the Paper


your preschooler in taping the feet outlines on the floor; then suggest that he follow the footprints. Show your child the Bible story picture. Remind him that Jesus walked on water.
