

Beginning in fall 2019, Bible Studies for Life: Students will be following a framework called Levels of Biblical Learning®. This framework—developed by a team of university professors and student pastors—provides a plan by which leaders can systematically teach theological truths and their applications. Bible Studies for Life equips leaders to teach these biblical truths and challenges students to live in light of them.

HOW IT WORKS

Levels of Biblical Learning is comprised of 52 theological statements, categorized into 10 main concept areas. These statements are presented differently to middle and high school students to ensure age-appropriate learning.

Each week of the year, students focus on one statement as they study the Bible together and individually. Over the course of one year they will have studied all 10 theological concept areas. Additionally, the three-year study plan allows students to work through each concept area three times. This repetition not only drives comprehension, but also helps students to understand how these theological concepts can be applied to all of life's issues.
