Bible Studies For Life: Preschool Worship enables kids to experience an interactive large-group worship in a kid-friendly setting! The curriculum can be customized to fit the needs of your kids, leaders, and worship environment. Included are Bible stories, worship songs, videos, games, Bible verse activities, and more. There also are ideas for small group activities if you have a drop-off time before the session begins or a pick-up time as parents arrive at the end of the session. In the chart below is a breakdown of a suggested schedule. Adapt it to fit your time and space.

PRODUCTION NOTES

Tailor *Preschool Worship* to your kids and leaders:

- For an easy prep: Enlist a Worship Leader to show the music videos and lead the songs. Prepare the Connection Point Game and Bible Verse activity, and show the videos for the Bible Story and Connection Point Missions.
- Have an additional leader? Enlist that person to lead the Connection Point Game, Bible Verse activity, and missions. Then prepare and tell the Bible story for an interactive experience with your kids.
- Do you have musicians who would like to lead worship songs? Check out the lead sheets on the DVD-ROM or substitute your songs.

HUDDLE UPS

Huddle Ups are optional activities for churches that have a drop-off time before the session begins or a pick-up time as parents arrive at the end of the session. It's a great time for interaction with a small group leader through games, conversations, or review questions.

- ➡ Estimated time: varies according to schedule
- ➡ Tech: none
- ➡ People: Small Group Leaders
- ➡ Supplies (for each small group):
 - Arrival Huddle Up—plastic laundry baskets with openings around the sides, ribbon, scissors (leader use only)
 - Bonus Huddle Up—crayons, “God Protected Moses” coloring sheet (1 per child)
 - Dismissal Huddle Up—colored construction paper, small paintbrushes (1 per child), several small cups, pitcher of water

ARRIVAL HUDDLE UP

(Form small groups. Lead the following Huddle Up activity as preschoolers arrive for worship time.)

Prep: Cut ribbon into 18-inch strips (several per child).

- Set a few laundry baskets on the floor and place strips of ribbon nearby.
- Show preschoolers how to weave a strip of ribbon through a hole in the basket.
- Allow boys and girls to work either independently or together as they weave ribbon in and out of the holes and around the sides of a basket.
- Say: “Someone might use a basket like this to carry toys or clothes. What other things could someone carry in a basket?”
- Talk with preschoolers about different uses for a basket at home or at church.
- Explain that today’s Bible story is about a mother who hid something special inside a basket.
- **Materials Option:** Provide a variety of materials for preschoolers to weave through the baskets, such as yarn, crepe paper, scarves, and strips of construction paper.

BONUS HUDDLE UP

(This is an extra Huddle Up activity to be used during arrival or dismissal time.)

Prep: Print this session’s coloring sheet (available on the DVD-ROM).

- Comment that God kept Moses safe. God planned for Moses to grow up and help people.
- Distribute crayons and coloring sheets.
- Invite preschoolers to color on their pages.

DISMISSAL HUDDLE UP

(Lead small groups in the following Huddle Up activity as they wait for pick-up.)

Prep: Pour a small amount of water into the cups. Set the cups on a table within each child’s reach.

- Review the Life Point: **God can do anything.**
- Give each child a paintbrush and sheet of colored construction paper.
- Show preschoolers how to wet a paintbrush and use it to “paint” with water on the colored paper.
- Remind preschoolers that Moses’ mother painted the bottom of a basket with tar. Then she put her baby boy in the basket and set it in the tall grass at the edge of the river.
- Suggest a child paint water pictures of baby Moses and his family.
- Invite preschoolers to talk about the Bible story as they work.
- Remind the boys and girls that Jesus taught that God can do anything.

COUNTDOWN VIDEO

- ➡ Estimated time: 3 minutes
- ➡ Tech: “Countdown” video
- ➡ People: none
- ➡ Supplies: none
- ▶ *Play the video 3 minutes prior to the start of your worship time.*

WORSHIP SONG

- ➡ Estimated time: 3 minutes
- ➡ Tech: Music video, mics for singers, lights *(optional)*
- ➡ Music: “God, You Are Great (2 Samuel 7:22)” *(lead sheet available on DVD-ROM)* or download a worship song of your choice
- ➡ People: Worship Leader and/or Worship Team
- ➡ Supplies: none

WORSHIP LEADER

Hello, everyone! It’s so good to see you!

Who brought you to church today? Did you come with your family or with a friend? *(Allow for responses.)*

Before we sing, find a new friend and tell him how many brothers or sisters you have. *(Allow time for preschoolers to respond.)*

Great job, everyone! Now let’s learn a new song about how great God is!

(Preschoolers stand to sing.)

► Show the music video.

WELCOME AND PRAYER

- ➡ Estimated time: 5 minutes
- ➡ Tech: Life Point and Bible Verse slides
- ➡ People: Bible Story Leader
- ➡ Supplies: rattle or other baby toy

BIBLE STORY LEADER

I’m so glad that all of you came to church today. One of my favorite things to do is to talk about God with my friends at church.

I brought something today that I want to show you. *(Show the baby toy.)* What kind of person would enjoy playing with this? *(Allow for responses.)* I think so, too. A baby would like this toy.

Today’s Bible story is about a baby boy who was in danger! Do you think God can keep the baby safe? *(Allow for responses.)* Yes, He can! **God can do anything.**

► Show the Life Point slide.

God can do anything. Say that with me: **“God can do anything.”**

Let’s play a game. I’ll name an action, and you decide if it is something that you can do or something that only God can do. If the action is something that you can do, point to yourself. If it is something that only God can do, point up. *(Name the following actions and lead preschoolers to respond.)*

- Sing a song *(Point to self.)*
- Put stars in the sky *(Point up.)*
- Make flowers grow *(Point up.)*
- Play with toys *(Point to self.)*
- Cause the wind to blow *(Point up.)*

Great job, everyone! We know that God can put stars in the sky, make flowers grow, and cause the wind to blow because the Bible tells us that He can! The Bible teaches people what God is like.

Today’s Bible verse says that nothing is too hard for God! He can do anything! Listen as I say the Bible verse, and then we will say it together. *(Say your preferred version of the Bible verse. Lead preschoolers to repeat the verse after you.)*

► Show the Bible Verse slide.

BIBLE VERSE:

(Select your preferred version.)

- God can do all things. Job 42:2 *(Paraphrase)*
- I know that you can do anything. Job 42:2 *(CSB)*
- I know that thou canst do every thing. Job 42:2 *(KJV)*

God is wonderful! Nothing is too hard for God. Let’s pray and tell God how happy we are that He can do anything.

(Lead preschoolers to pray.)

CONNECTION POINT GAME

- ➡ Estimated time: 10 minutes
- ➡ Tech: *Connection Point Game* slide
- ➡ People: Connection Point Leader, 3 kids
- ➡ Supplies: 3 small laundry baskets (*reuse from Arrival Huddle Up activity*)

GAME INSTRUCTIONS:

- *Set the laundry baskets on the floor.*
- *Choose 3 players.*
- *Assign each player a laundry basket.*
- *Challenge players to stand in various positions in relation to the baskets:*
 - *Stand inside the basket.*
 - *Stand beside the basket.*
 - *Stand underneath the basket.*
 - *Stand far away from (or near to) the basket.*
 - *Stand in front of (or behind) the basket.*
- *Begin the game slowly and gradually increase speed as players understand the game. Keep the game fun and engaging. (It is OK to give the same instruction more than once.)*
- *Choose new participants and play again as your time allows.*

CONNECTION POINT LEADER

- ▶ *Show the Connection Point Game slide.*

It's time to play a game! Let's see how well you can follow instructions! Who would like to play? (*Choose three players.*)

Friends, your job is to listen carefully and do what I say to do. Let's practice! If I say to stand in front of your basket, what should you do? (*Guide players to move and stand in front of the baskets.*) Great job! What if I say to stand far away from your basket? (*Lead players to move far away.*)

OK, I think we are ready to play! Does everyone know what to do? (*Answer any questions and play the game.*)

That was fun! I liked when you had to stand inside of the basket!

In today's Bible story we will hear about a mom who put her baby inside of a basket and set it near the river. Hmm ... I wonder why. Let's sing another song, and then we will hear what happened to the baby.

WORSHIP SONG

- ➡ Estimated time: 3 minutes
- ➡ Tech: Music video, mics for singers, lights (*optional*)
- ➡ Music: "God's Love" (*lead sheet available on DVD-ROM*) or download a worship song of your choice
- ➡ People: Worship Leader and/or Worship Team
- ➡ Supplies: none

WORSHIP LEADER

Is there anything that is too hard for God to do? (*Allow for responses.*) **God can do anything!** Nothing is too hard for Him!

God is powerful, and He loves you very much! God cares for you and can help you. Let's stand and sing about God's love.

(*Preschoolers stand to sing.*)

- ▶ *Show the music video.*

BIBLE STORY

- ➡ Estimated time: 10 minutes
- ➡ Tech: *Bible Story* and *Christ Focus* slides; "Bible Story Time" video (*optional*)
- ➡ People: Bible Story Leader
- ➡ Supplies: Bible, potted ornamental grass, a few small items (*such as a crayon, button, and wooden bead*)

Option 1: Show the Bible Story video: "Bible Story Time." Conclude with prayer.

Option 2: Gather the suggested supplies and tell the following Bible story. Hide the items among the blades of grass.

BIBLE STORY LEADER

► *Show the Bible Story slide.*

(Show the plant.) Look what I have! Have you ever seen a plant like this one? What can you tell me about it? *(Lead preschoolers to tell about the plant's color, height, and so on.)*

If we look closely, I think we might find some things hidden in the grass. Let's see what we can find! *(Remove one item at a time from the plant and show it to the group.)*

Wow! We found several hidden things! That was a good hiding place!

Today's Bible story is about a mother who kept her baby hidden near some tall grass by the river. Listen as I tell you what happened.

(Open the Bible to Exodus 2.)

The Israelites lived in the land of Egypt. Pharaoh was their ruler, and he made the Israelites his servants. The Egyptians were unkind to the Israelites and forced them to work very hard. One day Pharaoh made a terrible law. He said that all of the Israelite baby boys must be taken away from their families. Pharaoh wanted to hurt the baby boys!

A girl named Miriam lived with her family in Egypt. Her mother had exciting news! Miriam would be a big sister! Soon, her baby brother was born. Miriam's family knew about Pharaoh's law, so they hid the baby to keep him safe. Miriam's mother had a plan!

(Read Exodus 2:3.)

When she could no longer hide him, [the baby's mother] got a ... basket for him and coated it with [tar]. She placed the child in it and set it among the reeds by the bank of the Nile [River].

Miriam's mother fixed a basket to keep the baby safe. She put the baby in the basket and placed it in some tall grass at the edge of the river. Miriam watched to see what would happen to her brother.

Pharaoh's daughter came to the river and saw the basket. She looked inside and found the baby. He was crying, and Pharaoh's daughter felt sorry for him.

Miriam came to Pharaoh's daughter and asked, "Should I find a woman to take care of the baby?"

"Yes! Go!" answered Pharaoh's daughter. Miriam ran and got her mother!

Pharaoh's daughter told Miriam's family to take care of the baby until he was older. God had kept him safe!

(Read Exodus 2:10.)

When the child grew older, [the baby's mother] brought him to Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. She named him Moses.

(Close the Bible.)

Wow! God kept baby Moses safe! God had good plans for Moses. God planned for Moses to grow up and help people.

► *Show the Christ Focus slide.*

Many years later, another very special baby was born. God sent Jesus! Jesus is EXTRA special because He is God's Son. God planned for Jesus to grow up and teach people about God. Jesus taught people that God can do anything!

Nothing is too hard for God. God can send rain, put clouds in the sky, and *(refer to the plant)* make plants grow! God also can hear us when we pray and can help us. God can do ANYTHING! Let's pray and thank God for the wonderful things that He can do.

(Lead preschoolers to pray.)

WORSHIP SONG AND OFFERING

- ➡ Estimated time: 3 minutes
- ➡ Tech: mics for singers, lights *(optional)*
- ➡ Music: Use a favorite song or download a worship song of your choice.
- ➡ People: Worship Leader and/or Worship Team
- ➡ Supplies: none

WORSHIP LEADER

Pharaoh wanted to take all of the baby boys away from their families, but God kept Moses safe! God loved baby Moses and took care of him.

God loves and takes care of us, too! God can help people because **God can do anything!**

Optional Giving Segment:

It's time to give an offering. Some of the money that people give at church helps others hear that God can do anything! If you would like to give an offering today,

(Give your own directions for how preschoolers can give their offerings. After you collect the offering, guide preschoolers to stand for the worship song.)

► *Play your selected worship song.*

CONNECTION POINT BIBLE VERSE

- ➡ Estimated time: 5-8 minutes
- ➡ Tech: *Connection Point Bible Verse* and *Bible Verse* slides
- ➡ People: Connection Point Leader, all kids
- ➡ Supplies: none

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS:

- *Select your preferred version of the Bible verse.*
- *Say the verse and lead preschoolers to repeat it after you.*
- *Lead preschoolers to play out actions from the Bible story as they say the Bible verse:*
 - *Rock a baby.*
 - *Carry a heavy basket.*
 - *Shield eyes to watch from afar.*
 - *Run in place to get mother.*
- *Repeat the verse and actions as your time allows.*

BIBLE VERSE:

(Select your preferred version.)

- God can do all things. Job 42:2 (*Paraphrase*)
- I know that you can do anything. Job 42:2 (*CSB*)
- I know that thou canst do every thing. Job 42:2 (*KJV*)

CONNECTION POINT LEADER

► *Show the Connection Point Bible Verse slide.*

It's time to say our Bible verse! Listen as I say the verse, and then we will say it together.

► *Show the Bible Verse slide.*

(Say the verse. Lead preschoolers to repeat the verse after you.)

God can do anything! God kept baby Moses safe from Pharaoh. Let's remember some things that happened in today's Bible story as we say together the Bible verse.

(Lead the activity.)

CONNECTION POINT MISSIONS

- ➡ Estimated time: 5-8 minutes
- ➡ Tech: *Connection Point Missions* and *Connect to Missions* slides; "Send Columbus" missions video
- ➡ People: Connection Point Leader
- ➡ Supplies: none

CONNECTION POINT LEADER

► *Show the Connection Point Missions slide.*

Columbus is the largest city in the state of Ohio. Lots of college students live in Columbus. Many people who live in the area love and support the local college football team. Let's watch a video to see what Columbus is like.

► *Show the missions video: "Send Columbus"*

► *Show the Connect to Missions slide.*

In Columbus, Ohio, you will find people who are rich, poor, young, old, and in-between. The college town is a great place to tell people from many countries about Jesus.

More churches are needed in Columbus because so many people live there. Let's pray for the churches and missionaries telling people in Columbus, Ohio, about Jesus.

(Lead preschoolers to pray.)

REAL LIFE CONNECTIONS

- ➔ Estimated time: 3-5 minutes
- ➔ Tech: *Real Life Connections* and *Life Point* slides
- ➔ People: Bible Story Leader
- ➔ Supplies: One Conversation Pages (1 per child), small laundry baskets (1 per every 10 kids)

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS:

- Quickly form small groups of about 10 kids each.
- Lead each group to stand in a line.
- Give the first child in each line a basket.
- Instruct the first child to pass the basket over his head to the person behind him.
- Lead groups to continue passing the basket down the line until it reaches the last person.
- Direct the last child to shout: “God can do anything!,” run to the front of the line, and begin passing the basket again.
- Continue as your time allows.

Leader note: Print this session’s One Conversation Page (available on the DVD-ROM).

BIBLE STORY LEADER

- Show the Real Life Connections slide.

Let’s hear what you remember about today’s Bible story. I’ll tell the story. When I stop, you tell me the word that comes next! Are you ready? *(Make the following statements. Lead preschoolers to supply the words in parenthesis.)*

- Pharaoh wanted to take all of the baby boys away from their *(families)*.
- Miriam’s mother hid her baby inside a *(basket)*.
- Miriam’s mother set the basket in some grass near the *(river)*.
- Pharaoh’s daughter found the baby. Miriam ran and got her *(mother)*.
- God kept the baby safe! God can do *(anything!)*

Nice work, everyone! Let’s play a game to help us remember today’s Bible story and that **God can do anything!**

(Lead the activity.)

- Show the Life Point slide.

God can do anything. Say that with me: **“God can do anything.”**

I am so happy that God kept Moses safe. Moses grew up and did many good things. He loved God and helped God’s people.

It’s been so nice to be at church with you today. Learning about God is great, and learning about God with friends like you is super great! I’ll see you next time!

Leader notes:

- If you plan to utilize the Dismissal Huddle Up, guide preschoolers to their small groups.
- Send each child home with a One Conversation Page. Suggest families check out the “At Home” discipleship option at the bottom of the page.

Decorating IDEAS

UNIT 1: A POWERFUL AND LOVING GOD

- Piece together large sheets of bulletin board paper to cover an entire focal wall. Tape the backs of the papers together, using clear packing tape. Use various colors of spray paint to create a graffiti wall. In the center of the paper use a fun, graffiti-style font to spray paint *GOD CAN DO ANYTHING*. Paint fun shapes and squiggles in various sizes and colors to fill the paper. Fill a paint brush with acrylic paint and flick it toward the paper to create paint splatters. Tape the finished artwork to a focal wall.
- Gather several drop cloths (*or bed sheets*) and spatter them with paint. Arrange the cloths on the floor of the stage area.
- Set a large A-frame ladder on the drop cloths. (*Ladder is for decorating purposes only. Keep away from children.*) Add other painting elements such as brushes, rollers, empty paint cans, paint trays, and so on.

UNIT 2: THE WORD OF GOD

- Search online for free Bible story illustrations. Print the illustrations and mount them on brightly colored papers. Display the illustrations around your worship area. (*Option: Print the Bible story coloring pages from the DVD-ROM.*)
- Place a table where children will see it as they arrive for worship. Fill the table with Bibles of various shapes, sizes, colors. Encourage kids to look at the Bibles and compare them.
- Cover a wall with bulletin board paper. Provide markers or crayons. Encourage kids to draw on the paper illustrations of their favorite Bible stories.

UNIT 3: GOD'S PROMISES

- Create a tree house theme for your stage area. Use nature items to accentuate the scene, such as: greenery, burlap, artificial flowers, and rocks.
- Use a large cardboard appliance box to fashion a tree house. Paint the box fun colors, using acrylic paints.
- Use colored crepe paper to make a rainbow that spans the width of your stage.
- Cut large cloud shapes from poster board. Glue cotton balls or quilting batting to cover each cloud shape. Attach the clouds to fishing line and hang them from the ceiling.

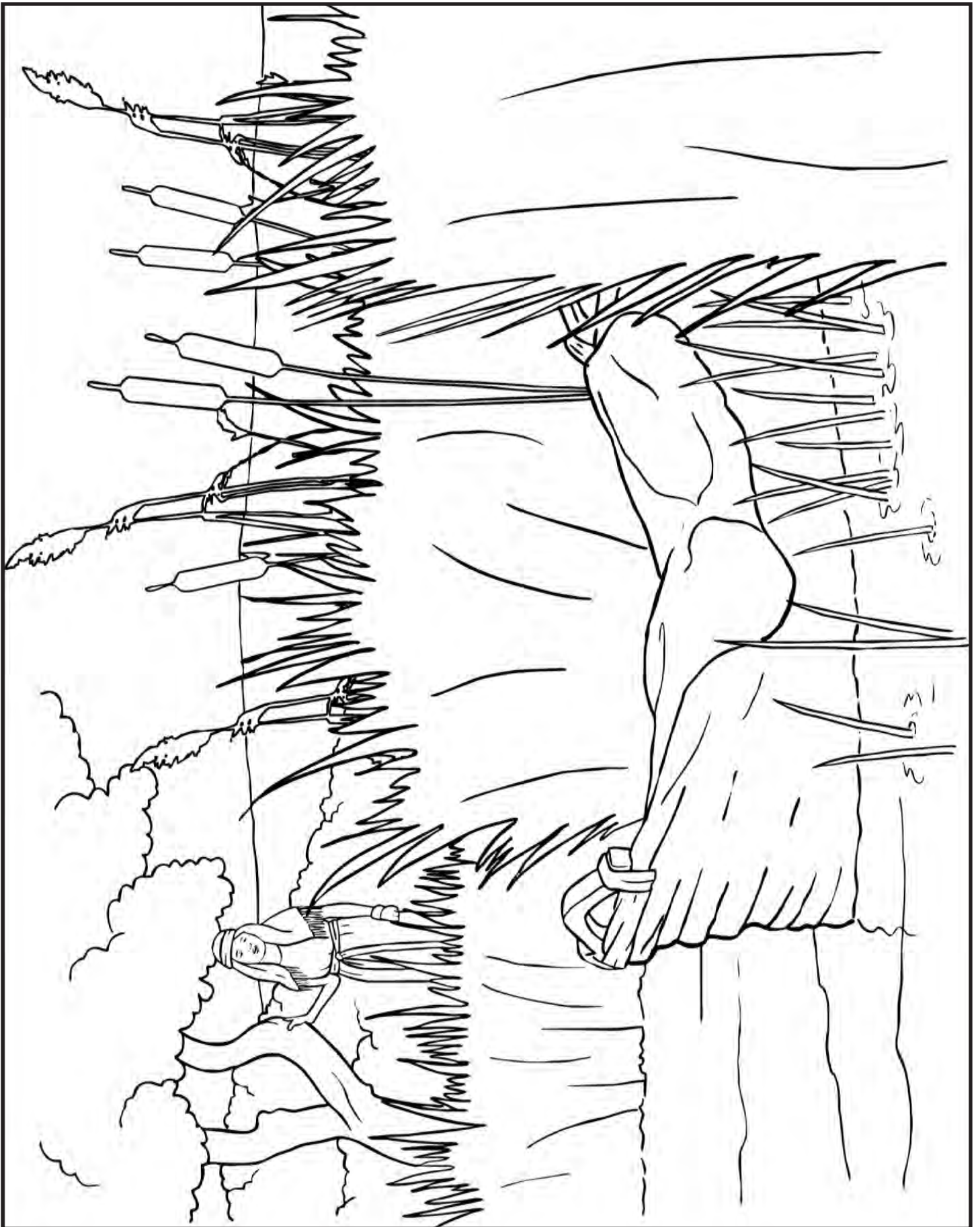

A woman named Jochebed (JAHK uh bed) had a baby boy. Pharaoh, the king of Egypt, did not want baby boys to live. For three months, Jochebed hid her baby. When she could not hide him any longer, Jochebed decided to do something to keep the baby safe. She took a basket made from tall grass and covered the outside of the basket with black, sticky tar. The tar would keep water out of the basket.

Jochebed placed her baby in the basket. She took the basket and set it in the tall grass near the edge of the Nile River. The baby's sister, Miriam, stayed near the river to watch her baby brother.

Pharaoh's daughter went to take a bath in the river. She saw the basket in the tall grass. She sent one of her helpers to get the basket. She opened the basket and saw the baby boy. He was crying. She felt sorry for him.

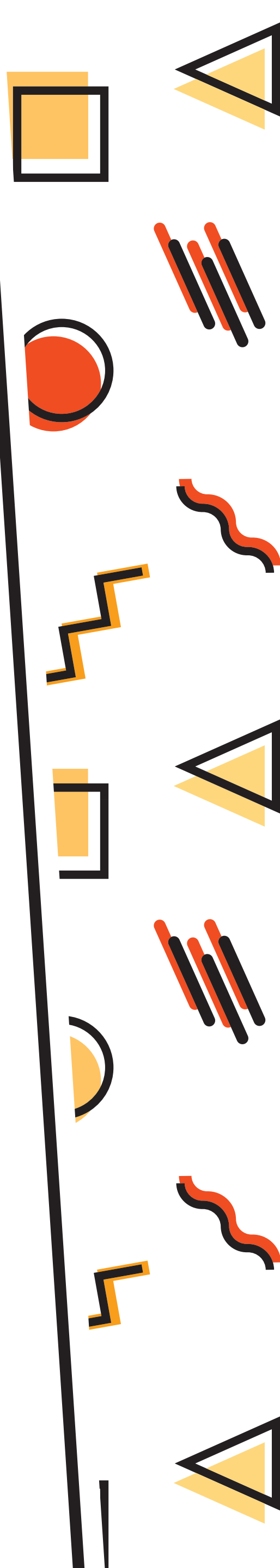

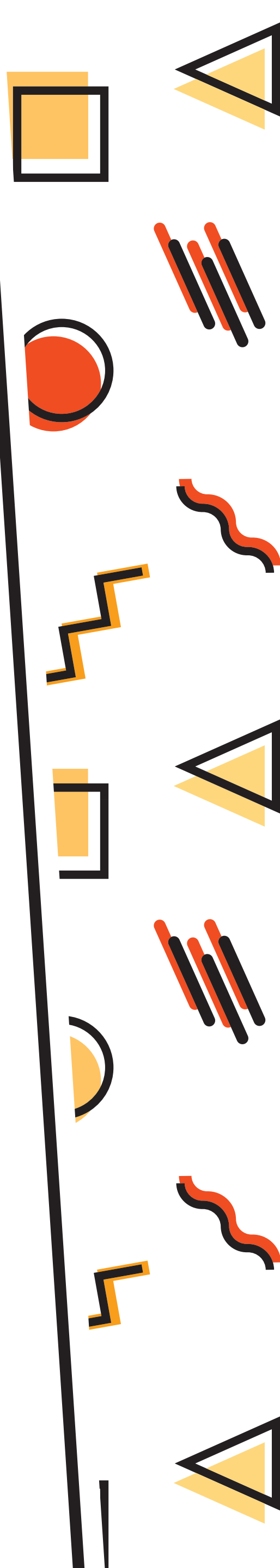

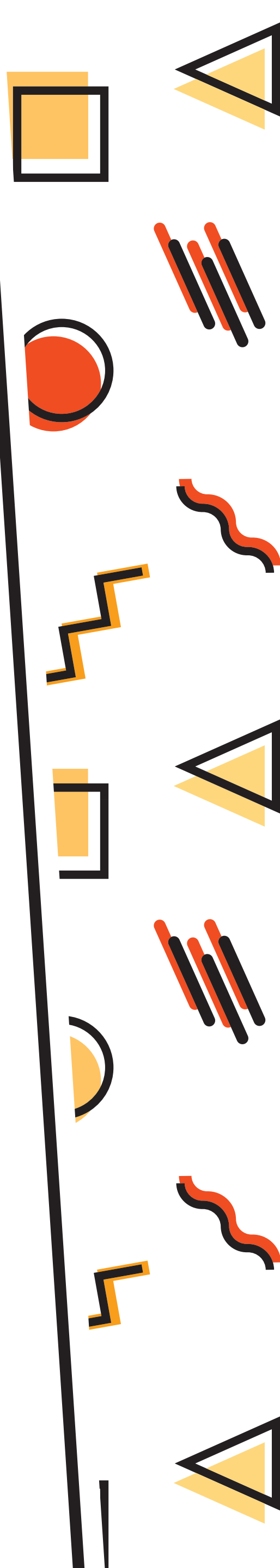
