#### CONTEXT AND COMMENTARY FOR PERSONAL STUDY AND PREPARATION

(For age-appropriate language, use the Bible story on the following pages )

After God miraculously brought His people through on dry ground, He drowned Pharaoh's horses, chariots, and his riders in the Red Sea (Exodus 14). God rescued His people in a way that no one could have imagined, and the people responded with fervent praise. They danced and sang with all their might, glorifying the God who rescued them (Exodus 15:1-22).

Three days later, the worship service became a distant memory. The people had traveled through the desert without nding water. When they nally discovered water, it was undrinkable. Their victory song quickly turned into a cacophony of groans.

This pattern of forgetfulness would come to de ne the Israelites. When God provided for them, they responded with praise. As soon as things became dicult, they would rebel against Him. Over and over, the Lord patiently reminded the Israelites that rescuing them was His plan and that He would be the One to see them through to the promised land. All they had to do was believe Him and obey His commands. God then proved Himself by going over and above what they needed. Sometimes that looked like 12 springs and 70 date palms. Sometimes it looked like manna in the morning and quail at night. Sometimes it looked like a weekly day of complete rest for a people who had been cruelly forced to work their entire lives.

God made it clear that the Israelites did not have to do anything to earn His provision. His gracious gifts were freely available. When the people saw how God provided for them, they would know that He was the Lord. All God wanted from them was their trust.

Jesus said, "This is the work of God—that you believe in the one he has sent" (John 6:29). As you pray this week, thank God for providing everything you need for an abundant life. Praise Him for His faithfulness and the promise of eternal life for all who believe.



#### **GROUP TIME**

- Play a game. Display one of the "wants" or "needs" items. If the item is something people need to live, lead the preschoolers to give a thumbs-up. If the item is a want, or something that is not needed to live, invite them to give a thumbs-down.
- Learn the Life Point. Point to the Session 3 Life Point Poster Addon. Say the Life Point together.
- Sing and move. Sing "God, You Are Great." Encourage the preschoolers to sing and move.
- Tell the Bible story. Say that the kids will learn about God providing for His people in today's Bible story. Open the Bible to Exodus 15. Display the teaching picture as you tell the Bible story.

#### **GOD PROVIDED FOR THE PEOPLE**

-Based on Exodus 15:22-16:36

After God used Moses to help the people cross the Red Sea on dry land, they traveled for three days without finding water they could drink. The people complained to Moses. God showed Moses where and how to get water for the people to drink.

The Israelite people kept moving from one place to another for many days. They complained again. They did not like being in the wilderness and not having enough food.

God heard them. He told Moses to tell them that He would provide what they needed.

That night God provided quail (meat) for them. The people ate. The next morning, the people saw something on the ground but did not know what it was. Moses told them it was the bread God promised. The bread was white and tasted like it had honey in it. Moses told the people to gather a certain amount of bread for each day. The people named the bread manna.

Many people obeyed God and gathered the manna the way God told them to. Some did not. The people learned to follow God's instructions. The people ate manna for many years.

- Review the Bible story. Invite several kids to choose review question cards. Ask the questions on the cards. Assist the preschoolers in answering the questions. Say that God provided for His people by giving them food and water. They learned that God helps people have what they need.
- Learn the Bible verse. Open the Bible to the verse marker. Read Philippians 4:19. Create a clapping rhythm for the preschoolers to follow. Lead them to clap the rhythm and repeat the words of the verse.
- Wrap it up and pray. Show the "God Provided for the People" video. Pray, thanking God for helping us have the things we need. Remark that many years later, God sent His Son Jesus to earth to teach people that God helps people have what they need.



#### **CHOOSE YOUR TIME**

Decide when to have group time; then select learning activities to use before and/or after group time.

#### MAKE A PLACE MAT

Print place mats on cardstock, one per child

- Encourage the preschoolers to complete their activity pages. Review the Bible story, reminding the boys and girls that God provided food and water for His people. Say that God helps people have what they need.
- Distribute a place mat to each child. Invite the kids to color the place mats and decorate with stickers. As the preschoolers complete their place mats, laminate or seal them with clear contact plastic.
- Say that food and water are two things that God provided for His people.
   Mention that He also provides these things for us too. Lead the boys and girls to name other things God provides for them.
- Comment that when the preschoolers use these place mats, they can remember that God provides the things they need to live. (Art)

#### **COLLECT MANNA**

Spread cotton balls on the floo

- Display the teaching picture. Invite the preschoolers to tell you what is happening in the picture.
- Review the Bible story, reminding the boys and girls that God provided quail and bread called *manna* for His people to eat. Say that the people collected manna in the mornings.
- Play "Autumn Medley" as the preschoolers work together to collect the "manna" (cotton balls) and place them in paper bags or baskets. Stop the music periodically. Lead the kids to pause and repeat the Life Point together: "God helps people have what they need."
- Repeat activity as time allows. (Music)

#### **PREPARE A MEAL**

Place today's verse marker in the Bible

- Assist a preschooler in opening the Bible to the verse marker. Read
   Philippians 4:19 aloud. Say that God helps people have what they need,
   just like He provided food and water for His people in the wilderness.
- Lead the preschoolers to name diff rent things they need to live. Mention that food is one of these things God provides for us.
- Invite the boys and girls to pretend to prepare and eat a meal using the
  play kitchen items. Encourage them to "cook," "serve," and "eat" the food
  together. As the preschoolers play, ask them to tell about some of their
  favorite foods to eat. (Dramatic Play)

#### **FIND PICTURES**

Write God Provides on poster board

 Talk with the children about things they need to live—water, food, clothing, shelter. Lead the boys and girls to look through the magazines or advertisements for pictures of some of the things they need. Assist them in cutting out the pictures.



## BIBLE-LEARNING ACTIVITIES

- Lead the kids to glue the pictures on the poster board. Display the poster for preschoolers to show their families when they are picked up.
- Pray with the boys and girls, thanking God for providing people with what they need. (Books)

#### **FIND OBJECTS**

Cut apart the Color/Number Cards

- Direct a child to choose a Color/Number Card. Name the color on the card. Invite the preschoolers to nd the number of items in the room that match the color and number of the card chosen. Say that the kids need to nd \_ (number on card chosen) things in the room that are \_\_\_\_ (color on card chosen). Repeat the activity several times using each of the cards.
- Remark that in this game, the preschoolers needed to nd certain numbers of objects that were a certain color.
- Mention that God provided food and water for His people. Say that the people needed to follow God's instructions to collect the food. (Games)

#### TASTE CRACKERS AND BREAD

Post the Allergy Alert

- Display the missions pictures. Mention that missionaries started new churches in Columbus, Ohio to tell people from other countries about Jesus. Say that God provides for the needs of both the missionaries and the people they tell about Jesus. Comment that sometimes the foods the people from other countries eat are diff rent than what we might eat.
- Invite the preschoolers to taste diff rent types of crackers and bread. Lead the kids to talk about which types of crackers they like and which they do not like.
- Remark that God provided bread called *manna* for His people while they were in wilderness. Say: "God helps people have what they need." (Nature)

#### **COLOR AND ASSEMBLE PUZZLES**

Cut apart the Unit 1 Puzzles

- Encourage the preschoolers to complete their coloring pages. Read God Is Powerful as the boys and girls color.
- Lead the children to talk about ways God is powerful. Mention that one way God shows His power is by helping people have what they need.
- Invite the kids to assemble the puzzles. As each puzzle half is matched together, guide the preschoolersto name one thing God provides for them.

#### TRANSITION/GROUP TIME

#### **SNACK**

Include the kids in the distribution of the snack. Ask for one or more volunteers to pray. Lead the boys and girls to clean up after the snack. Thank them for their help.

#### **MOVE TO GROUP TIME**

Lead the preschoolers to move to the group-time area while clapping a rhythm and saying, "God is powerful."

#### INTRODUCE THE BIBLE STORY

#### GOD PROVIDED FOR THE PEOPLE—BASED ON EXODUS 15:22-16:36

Gather the preschoolers in a circle on the oor. Toss a beanbag to a child. Invite her to name her favorite food. Repeat activity for each child.
 Say that in today's Bible story, God provided special food for His people.
 Open a Bible to Exodus 15. Tell the Bible story.

#### SUMMARIZE THE BIBLE STORY


- The Israelites traveled in the wilderness. They complained to Moses because there was no food or water.
- God heard His people. He told Moses He would provide.
- God provided quail (meat) in the evening. In the mornings He provided bread. The people called the bread *manna*.
- Moses told the people to gather a certain amount of bread for each day.
   Since the seventh day of the week was a day of rest, the people were to collect enough bread for two days on the sixth day of the week.
- God took care of His people by providing for their needs.

#### **REVIEW THE BIBLE STORY**

- Why did the Israelites complain to Moses?
- What did God provide for His people to eat?
- What did the people call the bread God sent?

#### EMPHASIZE THE LIFE POINT

• Say that God helps people have what they need.

#### SING TOGETHER

#### SAY THE BIBLE VERSE

Open a Bible to Philippians 4:19. Read the verse aloud. Invite the preschoolers to repeat the verse together. Lead the kids to say the verse using di erent voices. Suggest using a quiet voice, a loud voice, a robot voice, a singing voice, and so on. Mention that this Bible verse tells us that God provides what we need. Say that *needs* are things people must have to live, such as water, food, air to breathe, shelter, and clothing.

#### **PRAY**

Ask the kids to share any prayer requests they may have. Pray for these. Invite the boys and girls to share a response to a one-sentence prayer of thanksgiving for something God provides for them. Use a prayer such as, "Thank You, God, for "

#### BIBLE-LEARNING ACTIVITIES

Emphasize: God helps people have what they need.

- 1. Make a basket. Cut approximately 3 to 4 inches o the top of small paper bags, one per child. Distribute a bag and washable markers or crayons to each preschooler. Invite the boys and girls to decorate their bags. Assist the kids in creating handles for their baskets by taping two chenille stems to opposite sides of the top of the bags. Demonstrate how to tear white paper into small pieces to resemble manna. Invite the preschoolers to place several pieces of white paper in their baskets. Mention that God provided food for His people.
- 2. Create with play dough. Encourage the preschoolers to create their favorite foods using play dough. Invite them to show their foods and lead other kids to guess what the foods are. Mention that God provided for the Israelites, and He provides for us too.

- **3. Build with blocks.** Invite the preschoolers to name di erent things God provides that they need to live. Comment that God provides for our needs by helping us have food, water, clothing, and a place to live. Lead the boys and girls to build houses with blocks. Provide people gures for pretend play once the houses are complete.
- 4. Guess the food. Gather various toy food items. Place a food item in a bag. Instruct the preschoolers to place their hands in the bag and guess what food is inside without looking. Encourage them to use their hands to feel. Once every child has a chance to guess the item, take it out of the bag and see if they are correct. Continue playing as time allows. Mention that God helps people have what they need, including food and water.

#### **CLEAN UP**

Encourage the preschoolers to work together to clean up their activities. Thank them for listening and following directions.

#### **ROLL AND SAY**

Gather the preschoolers in a circle on the oor. Brie y review the Bible story. Comment that God provided food and water for His people while they were in the wilderness. Say the Life Point together: "God helps people have what they need." Gently roll a ball to a child in the circle. Ask him to name something God provides that they need to live. Invite him to say, "God provides \_\_\_\_\_." Lead him to roll the ball to another child in the circle. Continue activity as time allows. As the preschoolers are picked up, move the circle in closer to continue playing the game.

#### **DISMISS**

Help the kids gather their papers and belongings. Thank them for coming. Remind the parents to review the Bible story on the Kids Activity Page.
