BIBLE STORY

- » Moses and the Israelite people camped in the wilderness.
- » Moses went up on the mountain to talk to God.
- » God told Moses how he and the people were to live and what to do and not do. God's words were written on stone tablets.
- » The people said they would do what God said.

BIBLE WORDS 4

Moses, mountain, stone tablets

◆ Display "Door Poster Unit 1" (Item 17) outside the room door. Display "Signs" (Item 32) as needed.

PLAY IN A TENT

Gather: Pack Items 9, 31: "Bible Verses," "Bible People" (Adult Moses); Bible, blankets, small table or chairs, scissors, large craft stick, tape

Do: Separate today's verse strip and place in the Bible. Drape blankets over a small table tall enough for babies to crawl under it or arrange the blankets across several chairs to make a tent. Cut out the adult Moses figure and tape to the craft stick. Place the Moses figure and Bible in the tent.

- Call the babies to join you at the tent.
- Mention that we sometimes sleep in a tent when we are camping.
- Tell that Moses and the Israelite people camped in the wilderness.
- Show the Moses figure as you tell the Bible story.
- Comment that God told Moses how he and the people were to live and what to do and not do.
- Help a baby open the Bible to the verse strip. Read aloud: "We will do what God says. Exodus 19:8."

FIND STONE TABLETS

Gather: Pack Items 11, 20: "Bible Words 3 & 4," "Moses Story Pictures" (stone tablets); scissors, tape

Do: Separate today's Bible Words. Cut out the stone tablets. Tape the Bible Words and stone tablets around the room at different heights.

- Suggest the babies find the stone tablets. Tell the babies to look high and low, motioning with your hands. Carry infants to see the tablets.
- Point to the Bible Words as you tell the Bible story.
- · Comment that God's words were written on stone tablets.
- · Say: "God tells us what He wants us to know and do."

ROLL A BALL

Gather: Printables: "Unit 1 Missions"; tape, inflatable globe ball

Do: Tape the missions pictures in a line on the floor. Inflate the globe ball.


- Sit on the floor with a baby and roll the globe ball over the missions pictures to him.
- Encourage the baby to roll the ball back to you.
- Look at and talk about the pictures after you roll the ball several times.
- Hold a younger baby in your lap and look at the pictures and globe together.
- · Talk about the Taylor and Surh families' work in Ohio.
- State that missionaries tell people about Jesus and what God said about how to live.
- Comment that missionaries tell people Jesus taught that the most important rule is to love God.

PULL A RIBBON


Gather: Pack Item 3: "Teaching Pictures 3 & 4"; scissors, shoebox, ribbon, ruler

Do: Cut apart the teaching pictures. Tape Teaching Picture 4 to the shoebox lid. Poke several small holes in the sides of the shoebox. Cut ribbon in 6- to 8-inch pieces. Thread each ribbon through a hole. Tie a knot at both ends of the ribbon. Pull the ribbons so that only the knots show on the outside of the box.


- Show the babies how to pull a knot to make the ribbon come out.
- Point to the teaching picture as you tell the Bible story. Lift the lid and pull the ribbons back in the box.
- Say: "God tells us what He wants us to know and do."












