Bible Studies For Life: Preschool Worship enables kids to experience an interactive large-group worship in a kid-friendly setting! The curriculum can be customized to fit the needs of your kids, leaders, and worship environment. Included are Bible stories, worship songs, videos, games, Bible verse activities, and more. There also are ideas for small group activities if you have a drop-off time before the session begins or a pick-up time as parents arrive at the end of the session. In the chart below is a breakdown of a suggested schedule. Adapt it to fit your time and space.

PRODUCTION NOTES

Tailor *Preschool Worship* to your kids and leaders:

- For an easy prep: Enlist a Worship Leader to show the music videos and lead the songs. Prepare the Connection Point Game and Bible Verse activity, and show the videos for the Bible Story and Connection Point Missions.
- Have an additional leader? Enlist that person to lead the Connection Point Game, Bible Verse activity, and missions. Then prepare and tell the Bible story for an interactive experience with your kids.
- Do you have musicians who would like to lead worship songs? Check out the lead sheets on the DVD-ROM or substitute your songs.
- Need easy ideas for decorating your stage area? See “Decorating Tips” in the How-To section on the DVD-ROM.

HUDDLE UPS

Huddle Ups are optional activities for churches that have a drop-off time before the session begins or a pick-up time as parents arrive at the end of the session. It's a great time for interaction with a small group leader through games, conversations, or review questions.

- ➔ Estimated time: varies according to schedule
- ➔ Tech: none
- ➔ People: Small Group Leaders
- ➔ Supplies (*for each small group*):
 - Arrival Huddle Up—toy people figures, toy farm animals, construction paper, blocks
 - Bonus Huddle Up—crayons, “God Gave the Ten Commandments” coloring sheet (*1 per child*)
 - Dismissal Huddle Up—bulletin board paper, tape, crayons or washable markers

ARRIVAL HUDDLE UP

(Form small groups. Lead the following Huddle Up activity as preschoolers arrive for worship time.)

Prep: none

- Lead preschoolers to use the blocks to build a mountain.
- Suggest preschoolers use the other materials to build a campsite at the base of the mountain.
- Fold sheets of paper in half and stand them up to form tents for the figures to use as shelters.
- Recall that Moses and God's people traveled through the desert for many years.
- Remark that God always cared for His people and gave them the things they needed.
- Suggest preschoolers use the people figures to play out climbing the mountain.
- Mention that preschoolers will hear a Bible story about a day when Moses climbed a mountain and talked to God.

BONUS HUDDLE UP

(This is an extra Huddle Up activity to be used during arrival or dismissal time.)

Prep: Print this session's coloring sheet (available on the DVD-ROM).

- Comment that God gave Moses rules (*commands*) for the people to know and obey.
- Distribute crayons and coloring sheets.
- Invite preschoolers to color on their pages.

DISMISSAL HUDDLE UP

(Lead small groups in the following Huddle Up activity as they wait for pick-up.)

Prep: Cut a long sheet of bulletin board paper and tape it to the wall at child height. Draw a series of peaks and valleys along the length of the paper.

- Review the Life Point: **God tells us what He wants us to know and do.**
- Tell preschoolers that they will work together to create a mountain mural.
- Point out the peaks and valleys on the paper.
- Suggest that the peaks resemble mountains.
- Lead preschoolers to use crayons or markers to decorate a mountain range.
- Invite preschoolers to draw trees, animals, rocks, and so on.
- Suggest one child draw a picture of Moses on the mountain.
- Talk about the Bible story as the children work.
- Mention some specific commands that God said the people should know and obey. *(For example, God said that the people should love Him more than anything and use His name in good ways. God also said that people should obey their parents and always tell the truth.)*
- Remind preschoolers that they, too, should obey God's commands in the Bible.
- As time allows, lead preschoolers to say aloud your preferred version of Exodus 19:8.

COUNTDOWN VIDEO

- ➔ Estimated time: 3 minutes
 - ➔ Tech: “Countdown” video
 - ➔ People: none
 - ➔ Supplies: none
- *Play the video 3 minutes prior to the start of your worship time.*

WORSHIP SONG

- ➔ Estimated time: 3 minutes
- ➔ Tech: Music video, mics for singers, lights *(optional)*
- ➔ Music: “God, You Are Great (2 Samuel 7:22)” *(lead sheet available on DVD-ROM)* or download a worship song of your choice
- ➔ People: Worship Leader and/or Worship Team
- ➔ Supplies: none

WORSHIP LEADER

Thanks for coming to church today! Did anyone bring a friend? *(Allow for responses.)* I’m so glad we’re all here together.

Everyone, move around the room and find someone who is wearing the same color as you. Give that person a high TEN! That’s a high five with both hands at the same time! *(Allow preschoolers to respond.)*

That was fun! Now let’s begin our worship time by singing together about our great God!

(Preschoolers stand to sing.)

► *Show the music video.*

WELCOME AND PRAYER

- ➔ Estimated time: 5 minutes
- ➔ Tech: *Life Point* and *Bible Verse* slides
- ➔ People: Bible Story Leader
- ➔ Supplies: photo of a traffic light

BIBLE STORY LEADER

It’s great to be at church! How did you get to church today? *(Allow for responses.)* Some people walked to church, but most of you came in a car.

When grown-ups drive cars, there are rules that they must obey. *(Show the traffic light. Point to each light—red, yellow, and green. Invite preschoolers to identify the “rule” for each light. For example, stop, go slow, and go.)* What might happen if someone decided not to obey the rules? *(Allow for responses.)*

Rules can keep us safe and help us do the right things. The Bible has important rules called *commands*. The commands in the Bible are from God. They are God’s rules! God’s rules teach us to do what is right.

► *Show the Life Point slide.*

God tells us what He wants us to know and do.

Say that with me: **“God tells us what He wants us to know and do.”**

Do you think that we should obey God’s rules and do what He says to do? *(Allow for responses.)* Yes, we should! It is always a right choice to obey God.

Listen as I say today’s Bible verse, and then we will say it together. *(Say your preferred version of the Bible verse. Lead preschoolers to repeat the verse after you.)*

► *Show the Bible Verse slide.*

BIBLE VERSE:

(Select your preferred version.)

- We will do what God says.
Exodus 19:8 *(Paraphrase)*
- “We will do all that [God] has spoken.”
Exodus 19:8 *(CSB)*
- All that [God] hath spoken we will do.
Exodus 19:8 *(KJV)*

God wants us to do what He says because He loves us, and He wants good things for us. Let’s thank God for giving us rules so that we know what He wants us to do.

(Lead preschoolers to pray.)

CONNECTION POINT GAME

- ➡ Estimated time: 10 minutes
- ➡ Tech: *Connection Point Game* slide
- ➡ People: Connection Point Leader, 4 kids
- ➡ Supplies: construction paper (4 sheets each of 4 different colors), scissors (leader use only), tape

GAME INSTRUCTIONS:

- Gather 4 sheets of 1 color of construction paper. (For example, 4 sheets of yellow paper.)
- Cut a different shape from each sheet of paper: triangle, circle, square, heart.
- Repeat for each of the 3 remaining colors of construction paper.
- Scatter all 16 shapes on the floor and tape them in place.
- Choose 4 players.
- Challenge players to obey your instructions.
- Give instructions such as, “Stand on a green shape,” “Hop to a circle,” or “Take baby steps and move to a yellow shape.”
- Continue the game for several rounds.
- Choose 4 new players and play again.
- **Leader note:** Include everyone! Cut a set of shapes for every 3 or 4 preschoolers in your group. Allow more than 1 child to stand near any given color or shape.

CONNECTION POINT LEADER

- ▶ Show the *Connection Point Game* slide.

Look at all of these shapes on the floor! What shapes do you see? What colors do you see? (Allow preschoolers to respond.)

Let’s play a game with these shapes and colors! Who would like to play? (Choose four players or invite the whole group to play.)

To play this game, you will need to listen very carefully to my instructions and do what I say to do. Is everyone ready to play? (Answer any questions and play the game.)

What a fun game! You did a great job of listening and obeying! Way to go!

You knew what to do because you listened to my instructions. You did the things that I said to do. How do we know what GOD wants us to do? (Allow for responses.) We know what God wants us to do by reading the Bible. **God tells us what He wants us to know and do.**

After we sing another song, we will hear about a day when God told the people what they should do.

WORSHIP SONG

- ➡ Estimated time: 3 minutes
- ➡ Tech: Music video, mics for singers, lights (optional)
- ➡ Music: “God’s Love” (lead sheet available on DVD-ROM) or download a worship song of your choice
- ➡ People: Worship Leader and/or Worship Team
- ➡ Supplies: none

WORSHIP LEADER

God loves us and gave us rules (commands) to obey. Jesus said that we show how much we love Him when we do what He says to do!

Everyone, stand! Let’s sing together about God’s great love!

(Preschoolers stand to sing.)

- ▶ Show the music video.

BIBLE STORY

- ➡ Estimated time: 10 minutes
- ➡ Tech: *Bible Story* and *Christ Connection* slides; “Bible Story Time” video (optional)
- ➡ People: Bible Story Leader
- ➡ Supplies: Bible, marker board, marker, eraser, easel

Option 1: Show the Bible Story video: “Bible Story Time.” Conclude with prayer.

Option 2: Gather the suggested supplies and tell the following Bible story. Write a list of rules on the marker board: 1. Be grumpy; 2. Be kind; 3. Never listen. Set the marker board on an easel.

BIBLE STORY LEADER

► *Show the Bible Story slide.*

Friends, I need your help. I need your help. I'm working on a list of rules to obey at church, but some of these aren't right. Can you help me fix them?

(Allow for responses.) Oh, thank you!

The first rule says: "Be grumpy." Does that sound right to you? *(Allow for responses.)* No, God doesn't want us to be grumpy. Let's change this to "Be happy." *(Erase the word "grumpy" and write "happy" in its place.)*

The next rule says: "Be kind." Hmm ... that seems like a good rule to me. What do you think? *(Allow for responses.)* I agree! The Bible says that we should be kind to others. Let's keep this rule!

The last rule says: "Never listen." That doesn't sound like a good rule. We need to listen to our leaders and hear Bible stories. How can we fix this rule? *(Allow for responses.)* Good thinking! Let's change this to: "Always listen." *(Erase the word "never" and write "always" in its place.)*

Thanks for helping me! Now we know some of the rules we should obey at church. We should be happy, be kind, and always listen!

Did you know that God gives us rules to follow? God's rules are called *commands*. We can know God's commands by reading them in the Bible. Let me tell you a Bible story about some of the first commands that God gave to people.

(Open the Bible to Exodus 19.)

Moses and the people camped in front of a mountain called Mount Sinai (*SIGH* *nigh*). One day Moses went up the mountain to talk to God. God told Moses how the people should live. When Moses came down the mountain, he told the people what God had said for them to do.

(Read Exodus 19:8.)

Then all the people [said] together, "We will do all that [God] has spoken."

Moses went back up the mountain and talked with God again. God told Moses ten commands for the people to obey. The commands are called the Ten Commandments. God said that the people should

love Him more than anything and use His name in good ways. God also said that people should obey their parents and always tell the truth.

(Read Exodus 31:18.)

When [God] finished speaking with Moses on Mount Sinai, he gave him the two ... stone tablets.

God wrote His commands on stone tablets and gave them to Moses. Now the people could know the rules that God wanted them to obey. Then Moses spoke to the people again.

(Read Deuteronomy 5:1.)

"Israel, listen to the [commands] Learn and follow them carefully."

(Close the Bible.)

God gave us important commands in the Bible. The words in the Bible are special because they are God's words. The commands in the Bible teach us how to love God and love others.

► *Show the Christ Focus slide.*

Jesus said the most important command is to love God! We show God that we love Him when we obey His commands. Jesus always does what God says to do, and Jesus wants us to obey God, too!

Loving God and doing what He says is the right thing to do. Let's pray and ask God to help us obey His commands (*rules*).

(Lead preschoolers to pray.)

WORSHIP SONG AND OFFERING

- ➡ Estimated time: 3 minutes
- ➡ Tech: mics for singers, lights (*optional*)
- ➡ Music: Use a favorite song or download a worship song of your choice.
- ➡ People: Worship Leader and/or Worship Team
- ➡ Supplies: none

WORSHIP LEADER

God tells me to do what He says. Let's name three commands that the Bible says people should do. *(Count up on your fingers and lead preschoolers to repeat each statement after you.)*

- One—Love God.
- Two—Obey parents.
- Three—Tell the truth.

Great job! Those are three of God's commands. God wants us to obey Him and do what is right.

Optional Giving Segment:

It's time to give an offering. Some of the money that people give at church helps other know how to do what is right. If you would like to give an offering today, ...

(Give your own directions for how preschoolers can give their offerings. After you collect the offering, guide preschoolers to stand for the worship song.)

► *Play your selected worship song.*

CONNECTION POINT BIBLE VERSE

- ➡ Estimated time: 5-8 minutes
- ➡ Tech: *Connection Point Bible Verse* and *Bible Verse* slides
- ➡ People: Connection Point Leader, all kids
- ➡ Supplies: none

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS:

- *Select your preferred version of the Bible verse.*
- *Say the verse and lead preschoolers to repeat it after you.*
- *Remind preschoolers that God gave the people 10 commands.*
- *Explain that you will name an action and count aloud to 10.*
- *Challenge preschoolers to do the action as you count.*
- *Instruct the children to "freeze" after you count.*
- *Lead preschoolers to say aloud the Bible verse.*
- *Name a new action and play again as time allows.*
- *Suggested actions may include: hopping, clapping, stomping, wiggling, marching, and patting knees.*

BIBLE VERSE:

(Select your preferred version.)

- We will do what God says.
Exodus 19:8 *(Paraphrase)*
- "We will do all that [God] has spoken."
Exodus 19:8 *(CSB)*
- All that [God] hath spoken we will do.
Exodus 19:8 *(KJV)*

CONNECTION POINT LEADER

► *Show the Connection Point Bible Verse slide.*

It's time to say our Bible verse! Listen as I say the verse, and then we will say it together.

► *Show the Bible Verse slide.*

(Say the verse. Lead preschoolers to repeat the verse after you.)

This Bible verse says that we will do the things that God says to do. Do you think that is a good idea? *(Allow for responses.)* Yes! People should always do what God says. Jesus always does what God says, and we should, too!

(Lead the activity.)

CONNECTION POINT MISSIONS

- ➡ Estimated time: 5-8 minutes
- ➡ Tech: *Connection Point Missions* and *Connect to Missions* slides
- ➡ People: Connection Point Leader
- ➡ Supplies: none

CONNECTION POINT LEADER

► *Show the Connection Point Missions slide.*

Chroma Church is in Columbus, Ohio. The church wants people from many different countries to come and hear about Jesus.

► *Show the Connect to Missions slide.*

(Refer to the slide photo.) This is Isaac and Hannah Surh. Isaac is the pastor of Chroma Church. He and Hannah started the church so that more people could hear and learn about Jesus.

Let's pray that pastors and missionaries will start many more new churches in Ohio. Pray that many people will choose to trust Jesus.

(Lead preschoolers to pray.)

REAL LIFE CONNECTIONS

- ➔ Estimated time: 3-5 minutes
- ➔ Tech: *Real Life Connections* and *Life Point* slides
- ➔ People: Bible Story Leader
- ➔ Supplies: One Conversation Page (1 per child), jingle bells, 2 wooden blocks

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS:

- Explain that you will either jingle bells, tap together blocks, or clap your hands.
- Tell preschoolers to listen and respond based on the sound that you make:
 - Jingle bells—Spin around.
 - Tap together blocks—Put hands on head.
 - Clap hands—Sit on the floor.
- Make each sound and teach preschoolers the corresponding actions.
- Lead the activity, randomly playing each sound and challenging preschoolers to respond.
- Begin the activity slowly, gradually increasing speed as the children become more familiar with the challenge.
- Continue as your time allows.

Leader note: Print this session's One Conversation Page (available on the DVD-ROM).

BIBLE STORY LEADER

► Show the Real Life Connections slide.

God wants people to obey His commands. To *obey* God means to do what He says to do. Let's have some fun as we practice obeying!

(Lead the activity.)

I'm so proud of you! You listened and obeyed very well!

► Show the Life Point slide.

God tells us what He wants us to know and do.

Say that with me: **"God tells us what He wants us to know and do."**

It is important that people obey God. We should do the things that God says to do. How do we know what God wants us to do? *(Allow for responses.)* You're right! The Bible tells what God wants us to know and do!

Did you know that going to church is something that God said people should do? I'm so glad that you were at church today! I hope to see you again next time!

Leader notes:

- If you plan to utilize the Dismissal Huddle Up, guide preschoolers to their small groups.
- Send each child home with a One Conversation Page. Suggest families check out the "At Home" discipleship option at the bottom of the page.

Decorating IDEAS

UNIT 1: A POWERFUL AND LOVING GOD

- Piece together large sheets of bulletin board paper to cover an entire focal wall. Tape the backs of the papers together, using clear packing tape. Use various colors of spray paint to create a graffiti wall. In the center of the paper use a fun, graffiti-style font to spray paint *GOD CAN DO ANYTHING*. Paint fun shapes and squiggles in various sizes and colors to fill the paper. Fill a paint brush with acrylic paint and flick it toward the paper to create paint splatters. Tape the finished artwork to a focal wall.
- Gather several drop cloths (*or bed sheets*) and spatter them with paint. Arrange the cloths on the floor of the stage area.
- Set a large A-frame ladder on the drop cloths. (*Ladder is for decorating purposes only. Keep away from children.*) Add other painting elements such as brushes, rollers, empty paint cans, paint trays, and so on.

UNIT 2: THE WORD OF GOD

- Search online for free Bible story illustrations. Print the illustrations and mount them on brightly colored papers. Display the illustrations around your worship area. (*Option: Print the Bible story coloring pages from the DVD-ROM.*)
- Place a table where children will see it as they arrive for worship. Fill the table with Bibles of various shapes, sizes, colors. Encourage kids to look at the Bibles and compare them.
- Cover a wall with bulletin board paper. Provide markers or crayons. Encourage kids to draw on the paper illustrations of their favorite Bible stories.

UNIT 3: GOD'S PROMISES

- Create a tree house theme for your stage area. Use nature items to accentuate the scene, such as: greenery, burlap, artificial flowers, and rocks.
- Use a large cardboard appliance box to fashion a tree house. Paint the box fun colors, using acrylic paints.
- Use colored crepe paper to make a rainbow that spans the width of your stage.
- Cut large cloud shapes from poster board. Glue cotton balls or quilting batting to cover each cloud shape. Attach the clouds to fishing line and hang them from the ceiling.

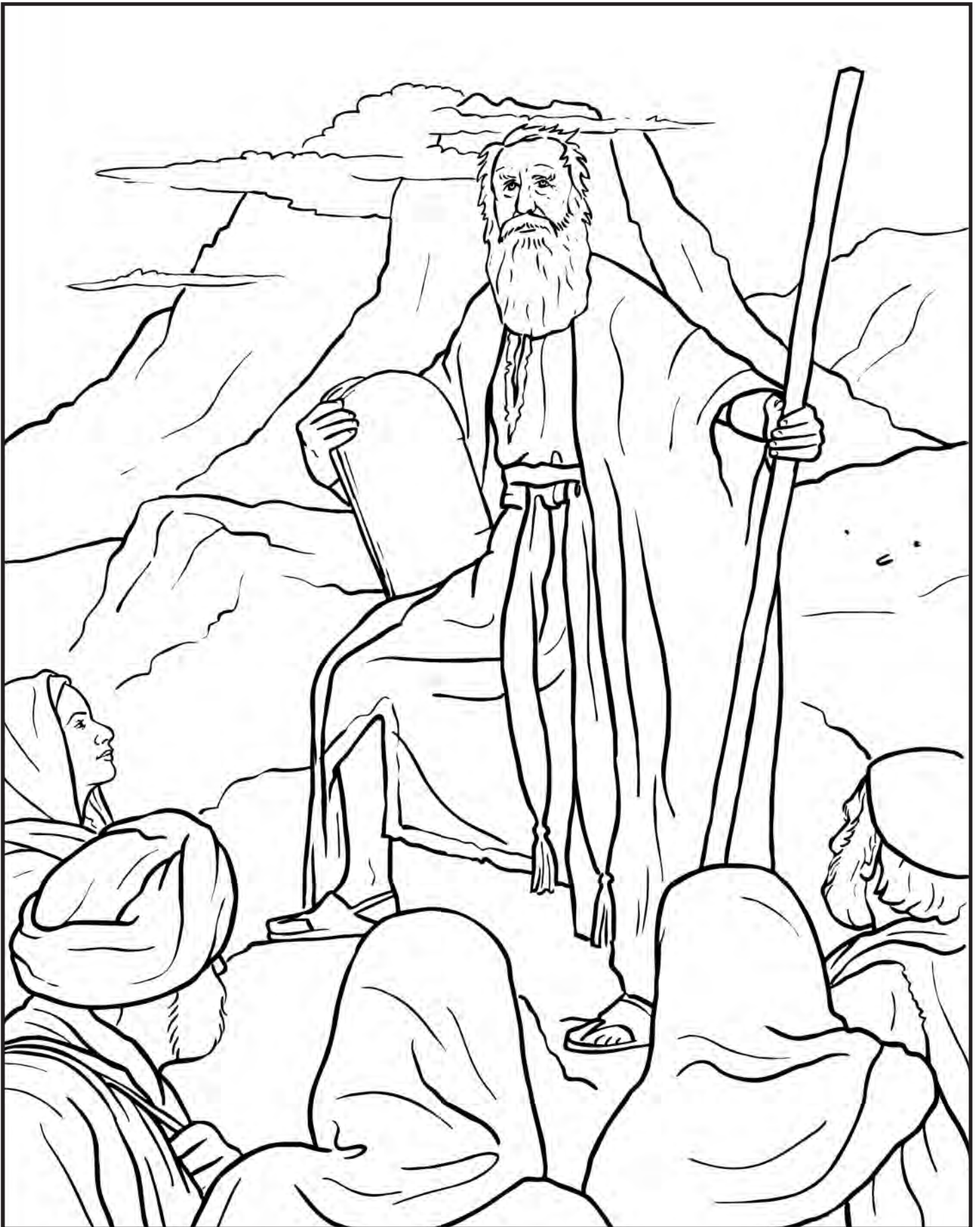

God Gave the Ten Commandments

After Moses and the people of Israel left Egypt, they camped in the desert. One day God told Moses to leave the camp and walk up a mountain. God wanted to talk to Moses. Moses went up the mountain to meet with God.

God said, “Moses, tell the people to obey Me. I want them to know the right things to do.” Moses went down the mountain and told the people. They said they would do what God said.

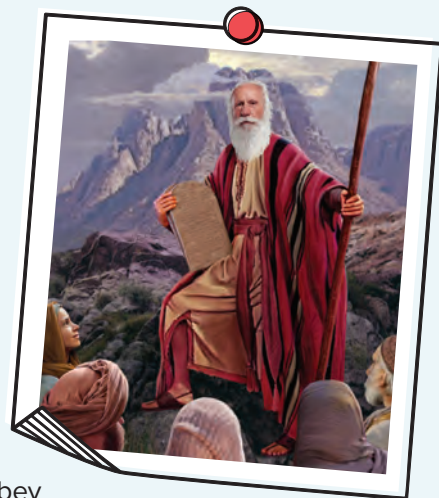
