Gently encourage your teen to stay on track and push yourself to do the same. We realize your lives are busy and many teens are stretched too thin, but this book will be most effective when students work through it one day at a time, rather than cramming just to get it done.

Connect

- Set aside time each week to work through the book and keep each other accountable.
- Be open with your teen throughout the week about the things you are learning or have questions about. Provide a safe place for him to do the same.
- **Don't stress! Make a plan and follow through.** If you need to go at your own pace, that's fine. Just don't give up if the road gets rough. The destination is worth the journey!

FAQ

Q: How old does my teen need to be for this study?

A: This study is recommended for teens ages 13 and up, but use your discernment as a parent.

Q: Are there videos to watch with my teen?

A: Yes. Video access comes with the purchase of your book.

Q: What if my child asks a question to which I don't know the answer?

A: Be open and honest—don't just make something up. Seek counsel from trusted sources like pastors and counselors. Most importantly, turn to God's Word.
