Weeks 1-3

Week 1 | Genesis 1:1–15 | “In the Beginning: Unveiling God’s Power” **FOCUS: Genesis 1:1–5, 26–28**

Why are we going through the Bible? The Word brought order, life, light, clarity, and purpose. Everything begins and ends with God, and His Word gives us purpose and meaning in life. The Creation Story is foundational, it sets in motion the metanarrative of Scripture: Creation, Fall, Redemption, and the Restoration of all things.

Call to Action: God has created everything for a purpose and for His glory. Have you found your purpose in life? Commit to regularly reading God’s Word so that He will enlighten you to His will, His way, and His love for your life.

Week 2 | Genesis 3 | “A World Turned Upside Down: Exploring the Impact of The Fall” **FOCUS: Genesis 3:1–7**

The Fall explains to us why everything in life is wrong, twisted, evil, and bad. Because of the Fall, all of creation has become subject to sin, evil, and death. Because of the Fall, we see so much heartache, pain, strife, and injustice in our world. The world desperately seeks in vain a solution to the predicament of evil and injustice that we are in. There is only One Person who can resolve our current situation, and even in the tragic story of the Fall, God “proclaims” a message of hope (Genesis 3:15).

Call to Action: Are you trying to “fix” your life issues on your own? There is only one true solution to “fix” all the sin and evil in this world.

Week 3 | Genesis 37 | “God’s Sovereignty in the Suffering” Lessons from Joseph” **FOCUS: Genesis 37:12–36**

No one likes to suffer, especially when it is unjust. The story of Joseph being sold into slavery by his brothers is one of the most tragic events in all of Scripture. Joseph suffered tremendously, but we can take comfort and encouragement from his own words twenty-plus years later when he said, “You planned evil against me; God planned it for good to bring about the present result—the survival of many people” (Genesis 50:20). Not only does the life of Joseph shows us the importance of forgiveness and reconciliation, but it also shows God’s sovereignty in how “We know that all things work together for the good of those who love God, who are called according to his purpose” (Romans 8:28).

Call to Action: How do you respond when we suffer unjustly? Are you willing by God’s strength to forgive those who have sinned against you? Make it a habit every day of laying at the feet of Jesus your burdens, resentments, anger, and bitterness that you have against others; highlight human trafficking ministries.


