

## How to Use The Gospel Project for Adults Commentary as a Supplement to the Leader Guide

The Gospel Project is a weekly Bible study created by Lifeway that helps adults dive deep into the larger storyline of the Bible—namely, God’s plan to rescue His people through His Son, Jesus Christ. Every session shows how all Scripture leads us to Jesus. It is a chronological study that examines the uniting gospel story and essential truths of Scripture. Over a three-year period, the chronological storyline of the good news of Jesus Christ, from Genesis to Revelation, will help individuals and groups understand the full gospel story. Through the study, gospel-centered discipleship centers our transformation on Jesus, not simply on moralistic thinking.

This video will show you, the group leader, how to use the Commentary as an additional resource to the Leader Guide. Before you watch further, you might want to watch the How to Use the Leader Guide video first. The Commentary provides more in-depth information than what is found in the Leader Guide, written in a more scholarly fashion, to aid in your understanding of the Scripture passage for the lesson. The Leader Guide has sufficient information for you, the leader, to facilitate and lead your group. But if you prefer to go even deeper, to provide more content for your group to think about, use the Commentary as a resource to help you get into the nuances of the text or to add additional insights for you to convey to your group.

Now, let’s look at the different elements of the Commentary found in each lesson.

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The first page of each lesson will have the title, the core passage, the key concept, and the Daily Readings, similar to the Personal Study Guide and the Leader Guide.

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The core passage will then be split into two parts with two subpoints that support the key concept, followed by extensive commentary to add to your knowledge of the passage.

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Questions from the Personal Study Guide are added to help you see what questions your group is answering in their personal study time.

On the side margins will be Christ Connections, Gospel Connections, Theology Connections, or Church Connections, helping you see how the passage may connect in these areas. These are also included in the Leader Guide and Personal Study Guide for the lesson.

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Occasional Voices from Church History or from the Church may also appear on the side, providing quotes that give insight to the passage from Christian thought leaders, past and present.

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For the conclusion of each session, the Head, Heart, and Hands application questions are the same as in the Personal Study Guide and Leader Guide. This serves as a reminder to follow the guide given in the Leader Guide to help your group consider how to apply the day's Scripture lesson.

Our hope is that the Commentary for The Gospel Project for Adults will help you have all the additional commentary you desire to have a fulfilling and deeper understanding of the Scripture passage for the lesson. Use it as a supplement to the Leader Guide, especially for a group that may be more seasoned in their knowledge of the Bible.
